



PROF. R. SRINIVASAN AWARD

FOR
LOW TEMPERATURE PHYSICS

Prof. R. Srinivasan Award for outstanding contribution in the field of **Low Temperature Physics** was instituted through an endowment fund established at UGC-DAE Consortium for Scientific Research, Indore by the students, colleagues and friends of Prof. Srinivasan.

The annual award consists of a citation and a cash prize of Rupees Twenty thousand, and is offered in recognition of notable contributions in the branch of experimental low temperature physics, on the basis of work carried out in India. The previous recipients are Dr. T.S. Radhakrishnan from IGCAR, Kalpakkam, Prof. K.G. Narayankhedkar from IIT, Mumbai, Prof. R. Nagarajan from TIFR, Mumbai, Dr. R.G. Sharma, from NPL & IUAC, New Delhi, Prof. A.K. Majumdar, from IITK & SNBNCBS, Kolkata and Shri P.N. Kush, from RRCAT, Indore.

Nominations for the award are invited. Nominations once made remain valid for two years, and can be updated. Nominations are to be made along with a detailed bio-data of the applicant highlighting the contributions in the field and 10 most significant publications for reference, and names of five referees. There is no age limit for the applicant. Nominations should be mailed to rsaward@csr.res.in with a subject line please write “**Nomination for RS award**” Awardee will be selected by an expert Committee formed by the Director, UGC-DAE Consortium for Scientific Research, Indore. The awardee shall give a lecture highlighting the achievements made by him and submit a written version of the talk.
